

Children's Handbook



We are pleased to welcome you back to school. We were all very sad and worried about when we would be able to welcome you back to school again.

So we are very happy to say that school will be open to you from 8th March 2021. However, the corridors and the classrooms will look a little different, but Mr Hopkins and the teachers will look the same.

We've put together some answers to the questions that you may have.



What time will I have to come to school?



There will be some changes to the school day and these have been done to stop the spreading of the nasty virus and to keep us all safe.

Normally, you all come to school at 8.50am and go home at 3.05pm, but the timings will change.

You will be given a time that is especially for you. It is important that you stick to your time.

Where do I go when I get to school?

Reception and Nursery children will enter through the Nursery gates and the teachers will be there to greet you.

Yr1, 2 and 3 children will enter through the blue door at the top of the Infant corridor - but don't worry, somebody will be there to greet you.



Yr4, 5 and 6 children will enter through the blue Junior door as usual and somebody will be there to greet you too.

Will I be going to my classroom with my teacher?

Once you have washed your hands you will be taken to a classroom. There you will meet the teacher for your Class Group. This means that you may not be with your own class teacher, but don't worry there will be a face that you know well and they will know you well too.



Will the lessons be the same?



Yes, lessons will be the same but the timings of the day will be different. PE days and timings may vary- so wear something comfortable on your feet (just in case!).

Will I be able to sit with my friends?

You will be in the same room as some of your friends but you will have your own table and equipment to use. It is really important that you do not share your equipment - it is just for you to use.

What about lunchtimes?

You will have lunch in the Hall with your Class Bubble

When you have left the classroom, some lovely people will come in and clean your desks ready for the afternoon lessons.

Do I have to wear school uniform?

Yes, we will return to school in our uniforms, it is most important that you wear clean clothes and don't forget those sensible shoes to do PE in. You will be told when it is your PE day and you will come to school in your PE kit (jogging suit and trainers/pumps, no jeans please)



Will I still be able to collect Dojos?



All of the teachers can't wait to start giving out Dojo's but there are some additional school rules that you will need to follow. Don't worry if you can't remember them - there will be posters in the corridors to help you.

Always keep your hands, feet, objects and bodily fluids to yourself.




When using the toilet, always follow instructions about washing your hands and moving around school.


Moving Around School
