<u>Lunchboxes</u>

We have children and staff at Severne who have nut allergies so therefore we ask that should your child bring any food into school, it should not contain nuts. This will help us to keep everybody safe.

<u>School timings</u>



Our school day begins at 8:30am and it is important that children arrive on time so that they are ready to learn and do not miss the start of their lessons. Our school finishes at 3:00pm and children should be collected promptly from their different classrooms or collection points.

<u>Cashless System</u>

I have had many parents asking me about the new cashless system and we are hoping to roll this out by the end of next week. Please look out for emails and text messages linked to this.

School Uniform

It is expected that ALL of our children wear the Severne Primary School uniform and on PE days wear their PE kit (see below). Children should not be wearing clothes with logo's on. All children are required to wear black shoes or trainers. Please ensure that your child has the correct uniform.

Boys - Navy blue sweatshirt, white shirt or polo shirt and grey trousers. For the summer months, grey school uniform shorts are acceptable.



Girls – Navy blue sweatshirt or cardigan, white shirt or polo shirt and grey skirt. Girls may also choose to wear grey trousers. Dark blue check gingham dresses may be worn during the summer months.



Shoes - Must be black school shoes or trainers



(All items should be plain <u>without logos</u> or decorations.). We urge parents to name all articles of clothing, including P.E. kit.

If headscarves are worn, they should be plain blue or white which are in keeping with uniform colours.



Important:

Please can all parents/carers ensure that they label all children's clothing so that if a jumper or cardigan is lost, we can return it to the right person easily.

As with our school uniform being smart and sensible, please ensure haircuts are smart/sensible too.

P.E. and Swimming

<u>P.E.</u>

Plain (no logos) pale blue T-shirt or polo shirt Plain navy blue school shorts Plain (no logos) navy blue joggers / jogging suit for colder days



All children must have appropriate footwear and socks, it is recommended that younger children should have plain black Velcro fastening pumps or black trainers for easy access.

Children are to wear school PE kit on PE Day and not school uniform.

<u>Swimming</u>

Swimming is part of our National Curriculum and all children are expected to participate fully in lessons when the opportunity arises for their class to attend.

Boys: trunks must be swimming trunks and **not** summer shorts. **Girls**: swimsuits must be one-piece suits and **not** 2-piece bikinis.

Please note: full body swimsuits (burqini) are permitted swimwear alternatively; lycra leggings and leotard can be used. Swimming caps are advisable but not essential.



All swimwear to be navy blue or black if possible.
