Birmingham City Council will offer free school meals for all Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children in schools from September 2014.

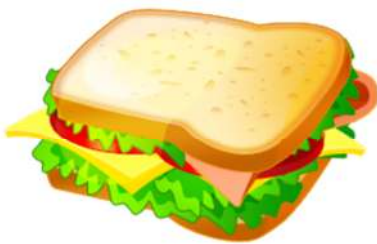
Research has shown that healthy free school meals improve children's learning and productivity, whilst saving you money.

The Number of children benefitting from free school meals in Birmingham has increased significantly over recent years and we have been getting great reports about the quality of our meals.

Our free schools meals meet strict nutritional standards, and we have received top marks from the Food Standards Agency for Food Hygiene.



Registering could raise money for your child's school



It's important to sign up for free school meals as registering could also raise an extra £1300 for your child's school from central government, to fund additional teaching staff, classroom assistants and extra resources, such as free music lessons.

Even if you don't want your child to receive a free meal, we would encourage you to register, if eligible, for free school meals so that our school receives the correct amount of pupil premium funding.

The information you provide in this form will be used by the school to claim extra grant money from the government to pay for free school meals, and pupil premium funding for our children.
