

Dear Parents/Carers,

Coronavirus Additional School Actions

In light of the Prime Minister's statement on Monday 16th March 2020, we are now taking the following additional measures to those outlined in my letter of Wednesday 11th March 2020.

This is to further reduce risk given the unprecedented circumstances.

- *All school assemblies will be suspended*
- *All traditional Easter activities (eg. Easter Hat Parade) will be suspended*
- *Parents' Evening (arranged for next week) will be postponed until the Summer Term (date to be arranged)*
- *No educational visits will now take place*
- *Note: We will keep Yr6 (Classes 1 and 2) Parents/Carers specifically informed regarding the Frank Chapman residential planned visit for May 2020).*
- *All swimming sessions will be delayed until the Summer Term*
- *All planned Music performances are suspended*
- *All after-school clubs WILL CONTINUE as normal*

Please can you make sure that school has your up to date contact details for you.

There will not be a blanket closure of schools at the moment. Should the decision be made by Government to close schools you will be notified via the existing channels.

We are busy making preparations for home learning activities should this happen.
